What is it?

- One-on-one appointments
- Ongoing personalized support
- Common Topics:
 - Study Strategies
 - Note-taking
 - Time Management
 - Procrastination & Motivation

How to schedule:



Meet with an Academic Success Navigator and be placed with a coach



ACADEMIC SKILLS COACHING

Examples:

- I play games or look at social media during class time.
- I take notes in a way that makes sense to me.
- I use a paper or digital calendar to track my due dates and exams.
- I wait until the night before an exam to start studying.
- I have enough time to finish my assignments each week.

What is it?

- A consistent time and place to make progress on schoolwork or other important tasks
 - Boost motivation & productivity
 - Limit distractions
 - Practice good academic habits
- Weekly 90-minute work sessions
 - Sessions meet Week 2 through Prep Week

WRITING & COMMUNICATION CONSULTATIONS

What is it?

- Appointments for individual or group assignments
 - Help with written, spoken, or visual projects
 - Not just for English classes!
- Personalized support from a trained peer tutor
- Common Topics
 - Organizing a paper
 - Revising a resume
 - Practicing a speech
 - Grad school application materials



WRITING & COMMUNICATION CONSULTATIONS

What is it?

- Small classroom setting, led by a trained peer who earned a B+ or higher in the course
- SI Sessions
 - 50 minutes each, 3 times per week
 - No need to sign up – attend as needed
 - Ask questions, clarify concepts from lecture
 - Exam Review sessions (very popular!)
- Offered for specific, traditionally challenging courses (mostly STEM)

Academic Success Navigator
Academic Success Navigators assist students who are looking for academic support, but aren't sure which service is best for them. In a one-on-one meeting, students share their goals and challenges and receive personalized referrals to ASC services and other campus resources to meet their individual needs.

Academic Skills Coaching
Academic Skills Coaching uses one-on-one meetings to help students examine academic concerns and perceived barriers to success. Students meet with a coach multiple times per semester to receive ongoing support in areas such as time management, studying and exam prep, and note taking strategies. Meet with an Academic Success Navigator to be placed with a coach!

Tutoring Services
Tutoring is available for free through Knack, a leading peer-to-peer tutoring platform, for students in eligible undergraduate courses. Tutoring is provided by a trained peer who has successfully completed the coursework for which they are providing support. Learn more at asc.dso.iastate.edu/tutoring

Supplemental Instruction (SI)
SI consists of regularly scheduled study sessions for select difficult courses. SI Leaders attend classes and facilitate group study activities emphasizing course content & study skills. SI is free and participation is voluntary. Find SI sessions at asc.dso.iastate.edu/sischedule

Writing & Communication Consultations
Communication Consultants work with students one-on-one at any stage of the writing process including brainstorming, researching, drafting, and revising. Consultants can also help students gain a clearer understanding of other writing topics such as focus, organization, structure, and formatting.
